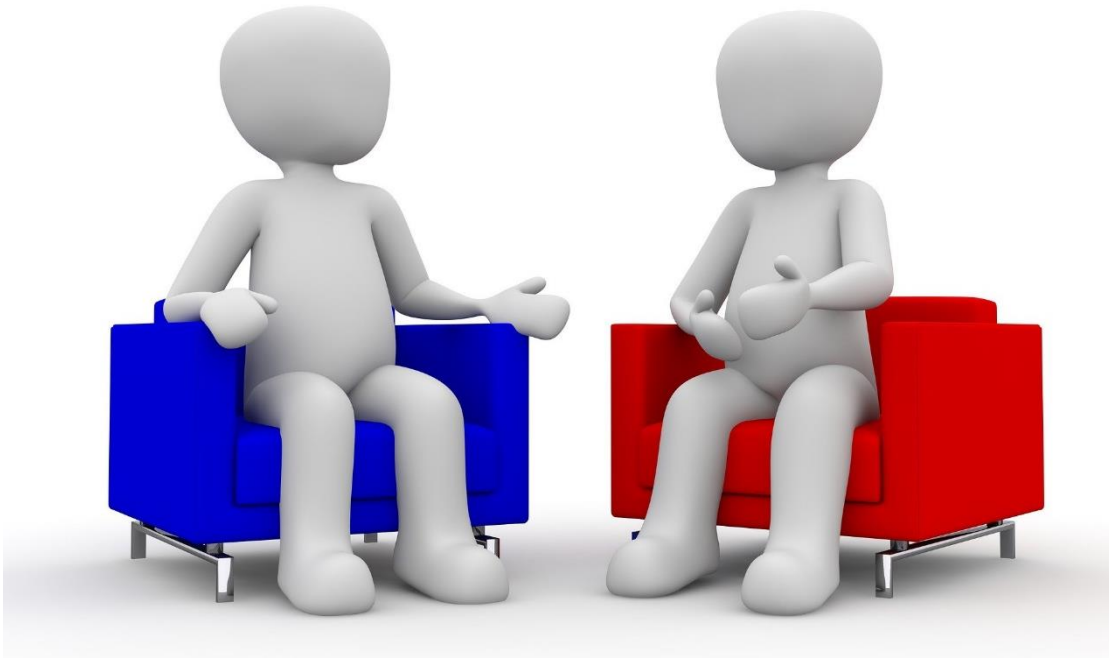


Be precise

You will be the ***care seeker*** in the other conversation



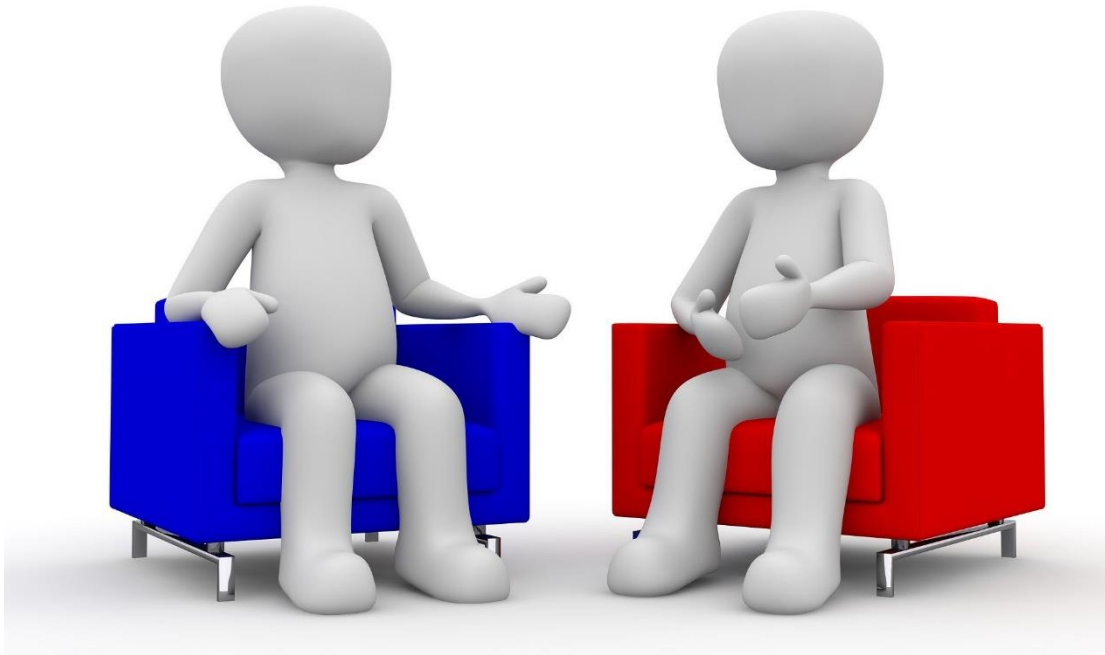
Spiritual Care Conversations
